April 2022 Newsletter Article

“But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb, taking the spices that they had prepared. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they went in, they did not find the body.” (Luke 24: 1-3)

One little 3-letter word, right at the beginning of Luke 24 sets the stage for all that is to come. We know that the word “but” negates what went before it, right? For example, “You’re qualified, but. . .” means you’re not really all that qualified. “I love you, but. . .” means that person doesn’t really love you for who you are. “But” lets us know that there is something else happening that we need to prepare ourselves for.

The end of Luke 23 is the burial of Jesus. He died on the cross on what we now call Good Friday. Joseph of Arimathea buried Jesus’ dead body in a tomb and rolled a large stone in front of it. The women were with Joseph when he buried Jesus so they would know where to go and anoint Jesus’ dead body for a proper burial. The last line of Luke 23:56 reads, “On the sabbath they rested according to the commandment.”

But. . .

“On the first day of the week—can you feel the excitement? Something’s going on here that no one expected to happen. “Why do you look for the living among the dead? Remember how He told you. . .”

Yes, Jesus had told His disciples a number of times that He would die, **but** would rise again! Often the disciples couldn’t get past the part of Jesus’ dying to hear what followed—that He would rise again. And Jesus did. And not only that, Jesus promised that we would rise from death as well. No ifs, ands, or buts. Thanks be to God for the promise of eternal life through our Lord and Savior Jesus, who was and is and is to come.
